


Fabric Birdie Pattern



— cutting line
- - - sewing line

What You'll Need:

Two contrasting fabrics that match, sewing scissors, pins, thread

Directions:

1. Cut out the bird body and the bird belly from two contrasting fabrics.
2. Pin 1 edge of the birdie's belly to the body (right sides together) starting from the tail.
3. The dotted line on the pattern indicates the seam allowance, simply sew the two pieces together using a straight stitch. Make sure you leave the tail end open to stuff your birdie.
4. Pin other edge and sew together the same way using a straight stitch on your sewing machine.
5. Next sew the head seam together along the dotted line.
6. Turn the birdie right side out and stuff using craft stuffing or the inside of an old pillow.
7. You can either hand sew the tail closed or use a zig zag on your sewing machine for an easy and neat finish.
