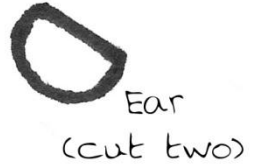
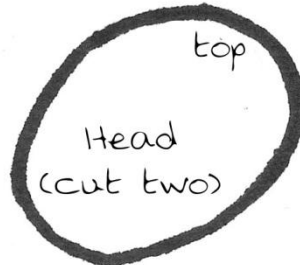
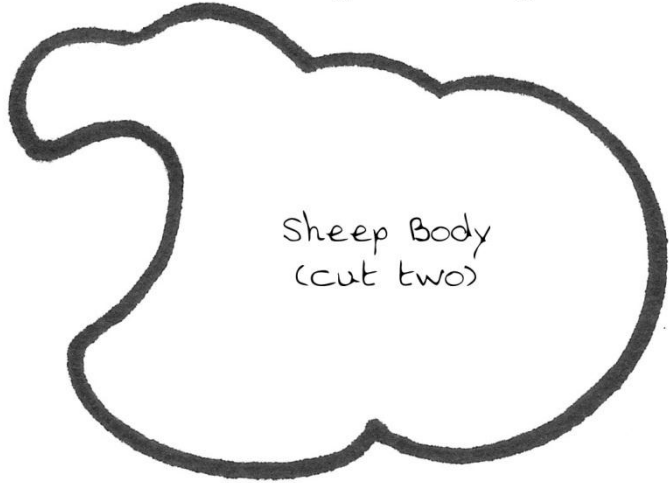


Sheep Mobile Pattern



SHEEP MOBILE PIECES



What You'll Need to Make a Sheep Mobile:

Felt in the colours of your choice for the sheep (I used a cream, white and black), felt in colours for the flowers (optional), embroidery thread to match, ribbon to hang the sheep, dowel to make the mobile, needle, sewing scissors, pins, toy filling, beads & foley bells for decorating (optional) and buttons if you intend to make the flowers (optional).

Directions to Make a the Sheep for a Mobile:

1. Cut out all the pieces in the colour felt that you have selected. You will need two of everything that is marked (cut two) above.
2. Sew the sheeps ears onto the body in the desired position. And make a french knot for the sheep's eyes on both pieces of the head (you can use a button if you prefer).
3. Position the head of the sheep between the two sheep body pieces and pin in place. Repeat this for the sheeps legs and tail (these are simply sewn in place and don't get stuffing).
4. Blanket stitch using embroidery thread right around the sheep's body and face but remember to stuff the sheep with toy filling before you close the sheep. If you find it easier you can do the sheep's head first then insert it in the correct place and stitch it to the body. (I did it all in one but it is a bit tricky).
5. The sheep are now finished, you can make the mobile how you like, but I simply used ribbon to attach the sheep to a piece of dowel and hang them in a row at different lengths. I decorated the mobile further using my Lissylane felt and button flowers, foley bells and pretty beads.

The pattern for the flowers is above, these are of course optional. Cut three pieces of felt in colours of your choice for each flower and secure the layers together with a pretty button.
